I have joined the Red Dot Campaign in an effort to reduce unwanted mail.

Please remove me from all unaddressed mail distribution. This letter, combined with a "No Junk Mail" sign on my mailbox, expresses my wish to stop receiving unaddressed flyers and mail. I also understand that Canada Post will still deliver some unaddressed items, such as community newspapers and letters from the House of Commons, provincial and municipal electoral offices and Elections Canada.

I have placed the "no junk mail" sign on my mail slot or box, or left it hanging out the back of my 'feed through slot' if I live in an apartment that uses these, to inform you and other carriers, and to help discourage other delivery services from delivering junk mail. I realize some services toss from the curb and that I may still get some unwanted mail."
